## We should, however become remorseful for a different reason. We should feel guilty and sad, when we think

of the enormity of God's love. Let me draw your attention to the parable of the two sons in Luk:15 we often describe this parable as the parable of the prodigalson, the real hero of the story is the father. When younger son returns home after squandering the wealth and living a delinquent life, the father embrasses him and gives

him a royal welcome. Similarly the father lovingly pleads with the older son to come inside the house and join in the celebration over the return of his brother. The father's love reaches out to both the sons without any limits. The word "prodigal" orginaly meant "lavish" "over generous". The bad meaning of the word "wasteful", squandering came only later. If we take the adjective "prodigal" in its orginal sence, then this parable may be

described as the parable of the "prodigal father" one who was overflowing and lavish in his love. The father's love on the cross should drive us to us to contrition. Our remorse should not be out of fear of judgiment, but because of the enormity of the God's love. In Marie corelli's novel -Barabbas- there is a touching scene. Barabbas who was set free from prison (instead of Jesus) goes to the foot of the cross, and seeing Jesus hanging on the cross felt so remorseful and uttered pointing to Jesus: "he died for me" (in my place ). Sathu Sunder Singh describes God's love thus. When I throw a stone at the fruit tree, the fruit tree throw no stone back, instead it gives me fruit. Is it not perfect love?
