General Instructions:

- *Repetition of verses should be avoided.*
- *Psalm 121 should be recited completely in sequence. References for memory verses are not compulsory.*
- *Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.*

1. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. (Matt 22: 37)
2. We should love one another. (1 John 4:11(b))
3. I will praise the LORD all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live. (Psalm 146:2)
4. I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go. (Psalm 32:8(a))
5. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. (2 Corinthians 5:17(a))
6. “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.” (Mark 10:14(b))
7. “The one who believes in me will live, even though they die” (John 11:25(b))
8. Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. (Proverbs 3:5)

11. The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. (Psalm 23:1)
