General Instructions:

- *Memory Verse Competition is scheduled to be held on 7th April 2017 during the Sunday school time.*
- *The duration of the written competition will be 30 minutes.*
- *Repetition of verses should be avoided. References for memory verses are not compulsory.*
- *Psalm 84 should be preferably written completely in sequence as given.*
- *Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.*

1. Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted. *(Galatians 6:1)*
2. Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. *(Galatians 6:2)*
3. If anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself. *(Galatians 6:3)*
4. Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship. *(Romans 12:1)*
5. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. *(Romans 12:2)*
6. Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. *(Proverbs 1:8)*
7. They will be a garland to grace your head and a chain to adorn your neck. *(Proverbs 1:9)*
8. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. *(Romans 6:12)*
9. A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. *(Proverbs 15:1)*
10. The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly. *(Proverbs 15:2)*
11. All a man's ways seem innocent to him, but motives are weighed by the LORD. *(Proverbs 16:2)*
12. Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and your plans will succeed. *(Proverbs 16:3)*
13. I can do everything through him who gives me strength. *(Philippians 4: 13)*
14. "Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. *(Mark 10:43-44)*

15. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (*Mark 10:45*)
16. Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. (*Romans 12:21*)
17. Do not withhold your mercy from me, O Lord; may your love and your truth always protect me. (*Psalms 41:11*)
18. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (*Colossians 3:17*)

25. They go from strength to strength, till each appears before God in Zion.
26. Hear my prayer, LORD God Almighty; listen to me, God of Jacob.
27. Look upon our shield, O God; look with favor on your anointed one.
28. Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked.
