**General Instructions:**

- ***Memory Verse Competition is scheduled to be held on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017 during the Sunday school time.***
- ***The duration of the written competition will be 30 minutes.***
- ***Repetition of verses should be avoided. References for memory verses are not compulsory.***
- ***Psalm 34 should be preferably written completely in sequence as given.***
- ***Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.***

1. Praise the Lord, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits. *(Psalm 103 : 1,2)*
2. Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

3. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! *(2 Corinthians 5:17)*
4. “Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.” *(Joshua 1:9)*
5. “Many are the plans in a man’s heart, but it is the Lord’s purpose that prevails.”  
*(Proverbs 19:21)*
6. For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. *(John 3:16)*
7. As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, O God. *(Psalm 42:1)*
8. Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid.  
*(Proverbs 12:1)*

9. I will extol the Lord at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.
10. My Soul will boast in the Lord; let the afflicted hear and rejoice
11. Glorify the Lord with me; let us exalt his name together
12. I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.
13. Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame

14. This poor man called and the Lord heard him; he Saved him out of all his troubles
15. The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him and he delivers them.
16. Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in him
17. Fear the Lord, you his saints, for those who fear him lack nothing
18. The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no good things
19. Come, my children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord
20. Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days
21. Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies
22. Turn from evil and do good seek peace and pursue it
23. The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry.
24. The face of the Lord is against those who do evil to cut off the memory of them from the earth.
25. The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles
26. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.
27. A righteous man may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all
28. He protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken
29. Evil will slay the wicked; the foes of the righteous will be condemned
30. The Lord redeems his servants; no one will be condemned who takes refuge in him.
