- ***Repetition of verses should be avoided. References for memory verses are not compulsory.***
- ***Psalm 91 should be preferably written completely in sequence as given.***
- ***Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.***

1. Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the seat of mockers. (Psalm 1:1)
2. The fear of the Lord teaches a man wisdom, and humility comes before honor. (Proverbs 15:33)
3. Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. (Psalm 51:1)
4. “Be joyful always pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus”. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
5. Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect. (Matthew 5:48)
6. The Sovereign Lord is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he enables me to go on the heights. (Habakkuk 3:19)

15. He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.
16. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
17. Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
18. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and your rampart.
19. You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
20. nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.
21. A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
22. You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.
23. If you make the most High your dwelling even the Lord, who is my refuge-
24. Then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.
25. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;
26. they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.
27. You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent.
28. "Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.
29. He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.
30. With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."
