General Instructions:

- *Memory Verse Competition is scheduled to be held on 7th April 2017 during the Sunday school time.*
- *The duration of the oral test will be 5 minutes for each participant.*
- *Repetition of verses should be avoided. References for memory verses are not compulsory.*
- *Psalm 19 and Psalm 146 should be recited completely in sequence.*
- *Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.*

1. A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. (Proverbs 15:1)
2. “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.” (Exodus 20:12)
3. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. (Psalm 119:11)
4. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:33)
5. Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of the sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. (Psalm 1:1)
6. The Lord loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of his unfailing love. (Psalm 33:1)
7. Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Unless the LORD watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain. (Psalm 127:1)

13. Which is like a bridegroom coming forth from his pavilion, like a champion rejoicing to run his course.
14. It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is hidden from its heat.
15. The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple.
16. The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.
17. The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure, and altogether righteous.

18. They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb.
19. By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
20. Who can discern his own errors? Forgive my hidden faults.
21. Keep your servant also from willful sins; may they not rule over me. Then will I be blameless, innocent of great transgression.
22. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.

Psalm 146

23. Praise the Lord. Praise the Lord, O my soul.
24. I will praise the Lord all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live.
25. Do not put your trust in princes, in mortal men, who cannot save.
26. When their spirit departs, they return to the ground; on that very day their plans come to nothing.
27. Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob; whose hope is in the Lord his God.
28. the Maker of heaven and earth, the sea and everything in them –the Lord who remains faithful forever.
29. He upholds the cause of the oppressed and gives food to the hungry. The Lord sets prisoners free,
30. The Lord gives sight to the blind, the Lord lifts up those who are bowed down, the Lord loves the righteous.
31. The Lord watches over the alien and sustains the fatherless and the widow, but he frustrates the ways of the wicked.
32. The Lord reigns forever, your God, O Zion, for all generations. Praise the Lord.

33. Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.
34. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.
35. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.
36. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
37. Share with the God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.
38. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.
39. Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.
40. Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.
41. Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone.
42. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
43. Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.
44. On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."
45. Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
