General Instructions

- *Memory Verse Competition is scheduled to be held on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017 during the Sunday school time.*
- *The duration of the written test will be 30 minutes.*
- *Repetition of verses should be avoided. References for memory verses should be written.*
- *Psalm 27 should be written completely in sequence as given.*
- *Only the first three positions will be eligible for prizes and only those who secure 50% or more will be considered for prizes.*

1. **2 Timothy 3:16-17** – All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
2. **Proverbs 18:10** – The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.
3. **Ephesians 4:29** – Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouth, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
4. **Ephesians 4:30** – And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
5. **Ephesians 4:31** – Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.
6. **Ephesians 4:32** – Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other just as in Christ God forgave you.
7. **Hebrews 13:5** – Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.”
8. **Psalm 139:13-14** – For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother’s womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
9. **Isaiah 40:28** – Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.
10. **Romans 8:28** – And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
11. **Isaiah 40:30-31** – Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

12. **Jeremiah 29:11** – “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”
13. **2 Corinthians 12:9** –But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.
14. **Psalms 1:1-2** –Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the LORD, and who meditates on his law day and night.
15. **Matthew 6:33**– But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
16. **Hebrews 13:25**– And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

### **Psalm 27**

17. The Lord is my light and my salvation whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life of whom shall I be afraid?
18. When the evil men advance against me to devour my flesh, when my enemies and my foes attack me they will stumble and fall.
19. Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, even then I will be confident.
20. One thing I ask of the Lord, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple.
21. For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his tabernacle and set me high upon a rock.
22. Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the Lord.
23. Hear my voice when I call, O Lord; be merciful to me and answer me.
24. My heart says of you “Seek his face!” Your face, Lord, I will seek.
25. Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, O God my Savior.
26. Though my father and mother forsake me, the Lord will receive me.
27. Teach me your way, O Lord; lead me in a straight path because of my oppressors.
28. Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes, for false witnesses rise up against me, breathing out violence.
29. I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.
30. Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.
